






**PP-ZUMERAK-SAMOBORSKO-GORJE.hr**


**PP-MEDVEDNICA.hr**



The Brijuni Islands were created by separating from what used to be the landmass of the Istrian peninsula. There is no other place with so much holm oak and bay laurel in one single surface, or so many endemic species, as the crowns of trees up to twenty meters wide.
